The University of East London (UEL) offers a wealth of modules across its five Schools to choose from while studying abroad. You can choose different departments/subject areas within **one School (unless otherwise agreed upon between UEL and your home institution)**. In some circumstances, we can approve one module from a different School outside of your course of studies. Please speak to an advisor within the International Office at your home institution to ensure you have selected the appropriate modules to transfer credit back to your home institution.

A standard course load at UEL would be 3 modules a semester (60 credits) or 6 modules a year (120 credits). Students can take up to 80 credits a semester, meaning you are able to complete a fourth module if you choose to. However, this will be assessed and approved on a case-by-case basis. When you apply, you will be asked to provide 6-8 choices (per semester). These selections will be used for our team to register your modules with the Student Records team, as students will not be able to register directly themselves. Some of these are to function as 'reserve' options in case we are unable to offer you your first choices of modules.

The level of a module is indicated in the course code, i.e., Level 4 modules (FT4XXX), Level 5 modules (FT5XXX), and Level 6 modules (FT6XXX).

Level 4 modules are 1st year offerings and are beginner/introductory level.

Level 5 modules are 2nd year offerings and are intermediate level.

Level 6 modules are 3rd year (final year) offerings and are advanced level.

Modules marked with * indicate pre-requisites, co-requisites, or pre-cursors. Your eligibility will be confirmed with the academic department before you will be able to officially register. Please note that module availability/offerings can be subject to change.

Due to the specialist nature of our course in Performing Arts, we offer incoming study abroad within distinct BA courses. Students must specialize in the same discipline as their home institution e.g. Dance, Acting, Music. We offer a single semester at Level 5 in Autumn, or a full academic year at **Level 5 only**.

We require students to study 3 co-requisite modules per semester to align with full time study on that course.

All prospective incoming study abroad students will be offered an interview with the course leader of their proposed host course and may be asked to provide a creative portfolio demonstrating their skills in the subject area. This is to ensure that students have the pre-requisites needed to thrive with us.
